Purpose of the Job:

The role of the Tech Director is to serve the Worship Director in overseeing and coordinating worship operations at Mill City Church. The Tech Director takes on the responsibility of guarding the spiritual culture, vision and character of the Tech and Worship teams as assigned by the Worship Director.

Experience and knowledge required:

- High School diploma or equivalent; Associates or Bachelors preferred.
- Minimum of four years' experience as a vocation AVL technician.
- Ability to handle multiple projects effectively.
- Excellent verbal and interpersonal skills.
- Proficiency in Gmail, PCO, ProPresenter, digital audio consoles, Premier, Avid, youtube streaming, GrandMA3, DigiCo, and Black Magic, and Resi.
- Knowledge of advanced lighting techniques and video technology.
- Experience with digital networking protocols is preferred.
- Ability to coordinate and lead LIFT Team members.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Oversight of the Tech LIFT Team; communication, scheduling for all events, team check-ins, etc.
- Sunday technical oversight of all audio, video, and lighting.
- Weekly repair and/or problem solving of any technology or equipment.
- Providing different trainings to volunteers throughout the year.
- Working with the Worship Director on planning and supporting non-Sunday events.
- Providing Video support to the online location.

- Attend weekly Staff Meetings
- Attend annual staff retreat.
